

#### **Quick Facts**

- There are 322,076 Hispanic American-owned employer firms in the U.S..
- Hispanic American-owned employer firms contribute \$423 billion in U.S. economic output and 2.87 million jobs per year.
- Hispanic American-owned firms with employees average 9 workers and \$1.3 million in annual receipts.
- Hispanic American-owned firms more concentrated in California, Florida, Illinois, Texas, New Jersey, New York, and Arizona.

## **ENTREPRENEURIAL PARITY OFFERS GREATER ECONOMIC IMPACT**

Our calculations of entrepreneurial parity predict minority business enterprise performance if it were to match nonminority business performance in terms of firms per adult population, dollar receipts per firm, and number of paid employees per firm (applicable to employer-firms, only). The difference between actual and parity can be viewed as an "opportunity gap."





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#### **Gross Receipt Percentage of Hispanic American-Owned Firms**




#### **Industry Sectors of Hispanic American-Owned Firms**
