## **Quick Facts:**


- In 2018, there were over 158 thousand businesses in New Mexico, of which more than 59 thousand were minority-owned firms.
- Minority-owned firms in New Mexico employed over 88 thousand people in 2018.
- Minority-owned firms represented 39.2% of all firms located in the state.
- The number of minorityowned firms in New Mexico increased 3.7% between 2017 and 2018.

## **Estimated Change in Number of Firms and Employees 2017 - 2018**




# **Population Stats:**

- Adult population describes adults 18 - 65 years old in 2018.
- In 2018, 63.3% of New Mexico adults identified as minority.
- Hispanics made up 48.9% of the state's total adult population and 33.4% of all firm owners in 2018.
- Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander's made up the smallest minority adult population in New Mexico in 2018.

## **Revenue Facts:**

- In 2018, minority women owned 41.7% of all minority-owned firms in the state.
- In 2018, minority-owned firms in New Mexico with annual receipts of \$500,000 or more represented only 6% of all minority-owned firms in the state.
- More than half of all minority-owned firms in New Mexico are concentrated in five industry sectors: Other Services; Construction; Administrative and support and waste management and remediation services; Healthcare and social assistance; Professional, scientific and technical services.
