



DOING BUSINESS IN KENYA FORUM

July 9, 2014 | Washington, D.C.

The Corporate Council on Africa, in partnership with the Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in Washington, D.C., will host a trade and investment forum titled “Doing Business in Kenya” on Tuesday, July 9, 2014. The forum will follow the 2014 Smithsonian Folklife Festival which will showcase Kenya’s rich and vibrant cultural heritage from June 25-July 6, 2014. The “Doing Business Forum” will focus on government recognized areas for investment and will be a unique opportunity for the U.S. and Kenyan private sectors to discuss and engage in mutually beneficial partnerships that are aligned with the Kenyan government’s economic and social transformation blueprint, the Vision 2030. The forum will convene senior U.S. and Kenyan private sector and government officials, as well as key decision makers from financial institutions and international organizations with a vested interest in Kenya’s development across many sectors including agribusiness, energy, finance and infrastructure. The forum will close with a networking reception.

MORE THAN 45 PPP PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES WILL BE PRESENTED, INCLUDING:

- **Agriculture:** Tana Delta Irrigation – expansion of irrigation scheme from 1,763Ha to 5,000Ha to produce 24,000 metric tons of rice/annum
- **Geothermal:** Implementation of 400MW Menengai Phase I – a green field electricity generation project with the objective of increasing the installed national capacity by an additional 400MW
- **Ports:** Conversion of Berth 11-14 into container terminals
- **ICT:** ICT Services at Kenyatta National Hospital (KNH) – development of ICT platform with several modules to manage hospital services including financial, procurement, drug supply, record management and patient management
