Ms. Gibson has significant experience in working with federal programs, grants and small business initiatives and has a strong working knowledge of federal, state and local procurement rules and regulations.

She previously was President/CEO of the consulting firm, Gibson & Associates, LLC, which was retained to develop and implement what became known as the Business Diversity Program, a minority and woman-owned business participation program that was used for the construction of the new H. Weir Cook Memorial Terminal at Indianapolis International Airport.

This program ultimately yielded almost \$250 million in federally and locally funded contracts that were awarded to 260 minority and woman-owned businesses. Additionally, when combined with the Indianapolis Airport project, her past experience in launching several statewide federally-funded development programs (annual budget of \$12 million) has afforded her a unique understanding of how to effectively manage successful partnerships between the private and public sectors.

Throughout her career, she has sought out unique projects that all have one thing in common – the ability to make a difference by bringing opportunity to those that otherwise may not make it to the table. She is committed to making a difference by fostering the full participation and entrepreneurial parity of minority business enterprises as described in the MBDA Funding Announcement.
