

Quick Facts

- There are 2.65 million Asian American-owned firms in the U.S. Of those, 577 thousand are firms with paid employees.
- Asian American-owned employer firms contribute \$863 billion and 5.09 million jobs to the U.S. economy.
- Asian American-owned employer firms average 8 workers and \$1.49 million in annual receipts.
- 57% of Asian American-owned firms are owned by men and 28% of firms are owned by women.

ACHIEVING ENTREPRENEURIAL PARITY OFFERS GREATER ECONOMIC IMPACT

Our calculations of entrepreneurial parity* predict minority business enterprise performance if it were to match non-minority business performance. The difference between actual and parity can be viewed as an "opportunity gap."



INDUSTRY SECTORS OF ALL ASIAN AMERICAN-OWNED FIRMS



- Asian American-owned firms are least concentrated in the Wholesale trade, Arts, Entertainment and recreation, Finance and insurance and Educational services sectors.
