

### **Quick Facts**

- ◆ There are 4.22 million Hispanic American-owned firms in the U.S. Of those, 331 thousand are firms with paid employees.
- Hispanic American-owned employer firms contribute \$455 billion in U.S. economic output and 2.97 million jobs.
- Hispanic American-owned firms with employees average
   workers and \$1.37 million in annual receipts.
- 25% of Hispanic American firms are owned by women and 62% of firms are owned by men.

#### ACHIEVING ENTREPRENEURIAL PARITY OFFERS GREATER ECONOMIC IMPACT

Our calculations of entrepreneurial parity\* predict minority business enterprise performance if it were to match non-minority business performance. The difference between actual and parity can be viewed as an "opportunity gap."



#### **INDUSTRY SECTORS OF ALL HISPANIC-OWNED FIRMS**


- Administrative and support and waste management and remediation services

- 17% of all Hispanic American-owned firms are within the Administrative and support and waste management and remediation services and Construction sectors.
- Hispanic American-owned firms are least concentrated in the Arts, Entertainment and recreation, Accommodation and food services, Educational services and Finance and insurance sectors.
