

### **Quick Facts**

- There are 46,653 Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander (NHPI)-owned firms in the U.S. Of those, slightly more than 6.65 thousand are firms with paid employees.
- NHPI-owned employer firms contribute \$11.17 billion in economic output and 54,446 jobs.
- NHPI-owned firms with employees average 8 workers and \$1.67 million in annual receipts.
- 30% of NHPI American firms are owned by women and 69% of firms are owned by men.

#### ACHIEVING ENTREPRENEURIAL PARITY OFFERS GREATER ECONOMIC IMPACT

Our calculations of entrepreneurial parity\* predict minority business enterprise performance if it were to match non-minority business performance. The difference between actual and parity can be viewed as an "opportunity gap."



#### **INDUSTRY SECTORS OF ALL NHPI-OWNED FIRMS**


- Transportation and warehousing
