


Quick Facts:

- In 2018, there were over 296 thousand businesses in Nevada, of which more than 106 thousand were minority-owned firms.
- Minority-owned firms in Nevada employed over 96 thousand people in 2018.
- Minority-owned firms represented 38.0% of all firms located in the state.
- The number of minorityowned firms in Nevada increased 8.8% between 2017 and 2018.

- Adult population describes adults 18 - 65 years old in 2018.
- In 2018, 51.1% of Nevada adults identified as minority.

- Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islanders made up the smallest minority adult population in Nevada in 2018.

Revenue Facts:

- In 2018, minority women owned 46.3% of all minority-owned firms in the state.
- In 2018, minority-owned firms in Nevada with annual receipts of \$500,000 or more represented only 4.3%of all minority-owned firms in the state.
- More than half of all minority-owned firms in Nevada are concentrated in four industry sectors: Transportation and warehousing; Other Services; Administrative and support and waste management and remediation services; Health care and social assistance.
