



Parity²:

In New Brunswick, NJ, no groups have achieved parity, in terms of population size and business ownership. In terms of population size and annual receipts, no group has achieved parity. (See below chart).

² Parity is defined as the proportionality between the population percentage and the percent share of number of firms owned by the group.
