Top Industries Among American Indian- and Alaska Native- Owned Businesses

- The industries with the highest average number of employees per firm are **depository credit intermedi-ation, nonresidential building construction**, and **other heavy and civil engineering construction**.

For employer firms, those in **depository credit intermediation** have the highest average annual receipts per firm **(\$12.3 million)**.

Gas stations have the highest average annual receipts **(\$230,000)** for nonemployers, compared to an average of \$29,000 for all American Indian- and Alaska Native-owned nonemployers.
