
Percentage of minority-owned businesses by industry group

- **7.1M** employees at minority-owned businesses
- **6.3M** at small firms with fewer than 500 employees (88.0%)
- **5.3M** at firms with fewer than 100 employees (74.2%)

Top Industries Among Minority-Owned Businesses

- The industries with the highest average number of employees per firm are **employment services**, warehousing and storage, and management of companies and enterprises.
- **Petroleum and petroleum products merchant wholesalers** have the highest average annual receipts per firm among both employers (\$37.3 million) and nonemployers (\$668,000), compared to industry-wide averages of \$81.2 million and \$656,000 respectively.
- **Gas stations** are the most likely to have paid employees. **88.3%** of minority-owned gas stations have paid employees, compared to 11.4% of all minority-owned firms.
